Flute

Technique for Band

This Scale Challenge will really test your ability to play in all 12 keys! Each direction change is in a new key. Memorize this Challenge to develop even more skill.

Remember: All 12 Every Day!

Part 1

Part 1 consists of 12 staves of music, each representing a different key signature. The keys are: B-flat major, B major, C major, C minor, D major, D minor, E major, E minor, F major, F minor, G major, and G minor. Each staff contains a sequence of notes and rests, typically in a 4/4 time signature, designed to be played as a continuous scale.

Part 2

Part 2 consists of 12 staves of music, each representing a different key signature. The keys are: A major, A minor, B-flat major, B major, C major, C minor, D major, D minor, E major, E minor, F major, and F minor.
